System Exploitation of x86/x64 Computers

- Compromised 8 systems using buffer overflows, format string vulnerabilities, and ROP chaining
- Developed custom scripts to automate remote attacks, optimizing exploitation on multiple systems
- Gained root access on each system by planting backdoors and implementing persistence techniques

WEP/WPA Insecurities

- Analyzed 12 WEP/WPA access points using Kismet, capturing beacon frames, SSIDs, and MACs
- Captured and cracked WPA handshakes; executed fake auth, ARP replay, and ChopChop attacks to expose encryption flaws
- Modified Aircrack-ng source code and rebuilt tool to support analysis of hidden or obfuscated SSIDs

Cybersecurity Audit for Nonprofit

- Conducted a cybersecurity audit for a nonprofit organization, identifying vulnerabilities and evaluating security practices against NIST IR 7621 guidelines
- Developed a tailored audit checklist to assess compliance and deliver targeted recommendations for strengthening organization's security posture
- Delivered a detailed risk report and presented mitigation strategies to leadership, improving organizational resilience and security awareness
